What is Local Link?

Gee Cross and Godley Local Link is a flexible public transport service you can use when you need it. You share the transport with other passengers to travel anywhere in your local area including:

- Godley;
- Gee Cross;
- Backbower;
- Newton; and
- Hyde South.

We'll pick you up from home and take you where you want to go.

It's ideal if you don't have a car and want to get to and from:

- the bus and railway stations at Ashton and Stalybridge, including Armentieres Square;
- Tameside and Hyde Hospitals;
- Mottram Library and town centre;
- Broadbottom and Newton Railway Stations;
- Gee Cross Post Office;
- Hyde Bus Station and town centre; and
- out and about in your local area.



Can everyone use Local Link?

Anybody who lives in the service area shown on the map in red, blue and green can use Local Link to travel to places in this area.

Our minibus is easy to get on and off and is child buggy and wheelchair friendly. If you have an assistance dog, you can bring it along too. Everybody's welcome!

How much does it cost?

- If you live in the **red** area, you can use it **Monday to Saturday** between **9.30am and 10.30pm**, and on **Sundays** between **10.30am and 10.30pm**.
- If you live in the **blue** area, you can use it **Monday to Saturday** between **6pm and 10.30pm**, and on **Sundays** between **10.30am and 10.30pm**.
- If you live in the **green** area, you can use it on **Sundays** between **10.30am and 7.30pm**.

How do I book my journey?

- Just phone us on **0161 343 6449**.
- Our booking office is open 24 hours a day.
- Please phone us at least one hour before you want to travel.
- You can book your journey up to one week in advance.
- You can book all your journeys for the week with one phone call.
- Please remember to tell us if you want a return journey.
